Top Tip! Intergenerational activities seek to add value to existing work...think about how you can involve another generation in what you do! Reach out to a group, setting, school or nursery in your local community to discuss ideas!

- Arrange an Intergenerational Christmas Party Send invitations to another group. Sing carols & Christmas songs, play pass the parcel, make Christmas crafts, wear fancy dress!
- Organise a Christmas themed quiz/Bingo Set up intergenerational teams, fun team names and give out prizes!
